Special Student Status

“Special Students” wishing to utilize F.A. must meet with your advisor to register for degree completion.

Drop-in Classes

Financial Aid students will be required to pay for classes taken in addition to the recommended course schedule (Fall 9 hours, Spring 9 hours, Summer 6 hours). Students may use Financial Aid funds to pay for these classes **only** if there is an available balance on hand at the time the cost is incurred. If there is no aid available, the student must self pay.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

Any student who withdraws from the program (permanently or temporarily) **will be** subject to Federal Regulations regarding the refund of student loans and grants. To receive full Financial Aid, a student must be enrolled at least half time per term (6 hours or greater).

STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT

In applying for financial aid while attending Southern Wesleyan University, the student acknowledges the following:

1. Applying for financial aid does not remove responsibility for payment. If funding is not received, or doesn't cover cost, the student must pay all outstanding balances immediately.
2. An insurance premium and a loan origination fee may be deducted by the lender from the student's loan proceeds prior to disbursement. This amount is estimated to be around 2.5%.
3. Withdrawal from the program, no matter what the reason, **will affect** the amount of aid a student can receive. Eligibility is based on the number of credit hours and the number of weeks of instructional time completed.
4. The college can only certify eligibility to apply for a student loan. Final determination of loan eligibility is made by the lender and the government guarantee agency.
5. Financial aid disbursements will be processed each term (Fall, Spring, Summer) provided a student is enrolled at least half time (6 hours or greater) in that term. The Academic Year is defined by those three terms and aid will be evenly disbursed in each term.
6. Financial aid is processed on a twelve-month basis. **Students must reapply every year.**
7. The student must be actively in attendance to receive financial aid money. Therefore, aid will not be disbursed between courses or programs.

Drug Abuse Prevention
